¹³ "Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. ¹⁴ For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it. —Matthew 7:13-14

The Recognition of the Eleven's Troubled Hearts

"Do not let your heart be troubled;

-When others withdrew, They continued to believe & follow (John 6:66-69) ⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life.⁶⁹ We have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God."

-They had found the way leading to eternal life & would not leave it

-When others opposed, They heard Christ's response (John 7:33-34, 8:21-24) ³³... "For a little while longer I am with you, then I go to Him who sent Me. ³⁴ You will seek Me, & will not find Me; & where I am, you cannot come."

²¹..."I go away,& you will seek Me,& will die in your sin; where I am going, you cannot come.... You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world. ²⁴ Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am (He), you will die in your sins."

-Christ's response to those wanting to seize Him (time hadn't come)

-You won't find me & cannot come

-You will die in your sin and cannot come where I am going

-Unless you believe that I AM (He) you will die in your sins

-When the time for Glory was announced, They heard they could not follow

³¹... "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him; ³² if God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately. ³³ Little children, I am with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, now I also say to you, 'Where I am going, you cannot come.'

-They wanted Christ's glory to be revealed so they could be rewarded -Glory to them meant establishing the Kingdom on Earth -Jesus announced that glory was immediate (Come into His Own) -Jesus said they could not come where he was going

-When Peter heard, He questioned & pledge his life (John 13:36-37) ³⁶ Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, where are You going?" Jesus answered, "Where I go, you cannot follow Me now; but you will follow later." ³⁷ Peter said to Him, "Lord, why can I not follow You right now? I will lay down my life for You." -You cannot follow now, but you will follow later -You are not able to bear the price

The Reminder to Trust in God and Jesus Christ

(You) believe in God, believe also in Me.

-You trust the promised word, trust the Present Word -Faith is required in the face of the unknown -Those who know Jesus must remember He's as trustworthy as God
