

WEIGHT of the WORLD #4 Releasing the Weight of Worry Philippians 4:4-7, 1 Peter 5:6-11 9/30/2018

<sup>23</sup> Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts; <sup>24</sup> And see if there be any hurtful way in me, And lead me in the everlasting way.
 -Psalm 139:23-24 NASB

-An anxious & worried heart isn't cute. Stop the "Bless Your Heart" approach

-It is a doubting & unbelieving heart that is not trusting the Lord

-It is a prideful heart seeking its own answers through its own strength

-This is a hurtful way in you Satan uses to steal peace/joy & kill credibility

-I believe, help my unbelief!

-Resisting the Onset of Despair

-Despair is produced when anxious thoughts & worry remain unchecked -Anxious & Worrisome thoughts come but must not be given a pass -Unchecked Worry always draws focus away from God & onto self -Take anxiety & worries captive to be made obedient to Christ

<sup>4</sup> Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! <sup>5</sup> Let your gentle spirit be known to all men. The Lord is near. <sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.. -Philippians 4:4-7 NASB

-Rejoice regardless of your circumstances

-Rejoice IN the Lord not rejoice FOR the Lord

-Not giving our praise to Him, but taking our joy from Him

-That's Important enough to bear repeating

-Be known by your gentle spirit -Our reputation before all people, whether in Christ or not (v. 5a)

(v. 4)

- -Be Anxious for nothing
  - -There is no situation in which anxiety should reign in the believer -Anxiety: Sense of dread gnawing at the pride of "handling it" alone -Anxiety: Believing the Lord isn't there or doesn't care
  - -The Lord is Near: Be making your requests known
  - -in everything by prayer & supplication with thanksgiving
    -prayer and anxiety: same trigger opposite response
    -don't choose to dwell on what you have no power to change
    -choose to dwell with the Lord who can change everything
  - -The Lord is Near: Be guarded in heart & mind by His peace -every circumstance has a purpose, Consider it joy -Keep resisting the devil and pray and trust in all circumstances

<sup>6</sup> Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, <sup>7</sup> casting all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you. <sup>8</sup> Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. <sup>10</sup> After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you. <sup>11</sup> To Him be dominion forever and ever. Amen.

## 1 Peter 5:6-11 NASB

-Embrace a faith filled with humble patience that trusts the Lord

-Trust His power and wisdom to deliver in due time

-Trust His character and care to know what the due time is -Engage in resisting the adversary who uses lies & fear

-Even in the face of temporary suffering

- -Expect God's faithful completion of His promise
- He will perfect, confirm, strengthen, & establish you

-There is no other dominion but His.

-humility, kindness, gentleness, forbearance, considerate -A pattern of life that exhibits the peace of the Lord

-Operating from a place of peace b/c of confidence in the Lord "God's got this..."

-Faith in His faithfulness

-Not a self-seeking desperation produced by anxious worry

"I Must Do Something ... "

-Flailing because of fear

-Live Convinced of the Lord's Identity &Proximity (v. 5b) -The *Lord* is near: Live convinced of the Lord's identity

-The Lord is <u>Near</u>: Live convinced of the Lord's proximity

-This phrase is the fulcrum of the passage The Lord is Near: Be Rejoicing; Be Gentle;

The Lord is near: Be Abiding instead of Anxious

(v. 6-7)
